Beautification Update

Median at 75 & Henderson:

CHNA has been working with local architect Jessie Zarazaga to beautify the median on Henderson between Church's Chicken and Sleep Experts, so as to enhance the entrance to Cochran Heights.

Jessie has donated her time and money to create the proposed design which can be seen at the Xmas party.

The project will cost in the range of \$6 - \$10,000. CHNA will begin work on the median as soon as possible and is working with the Dallas Mowmentum

Program to receive funding for 50% of the project. More details will be supplied at the Xmas party.

Sidewalk Program:

CHNA is still awaiting word from the City on how much bond money it will receive for the Sidewalk Replacement Program

Street Sign Toppers:

CHNA has received bids for new street sign toppers for the neighborhood. Double-sided reflective signs cost approximately \$120 for manufacture and installation. We have decided to start with 15 signs and have selected a few color choices for people to chose from at the Xmas party.

Mission Park:

We are currently working on ideas to provide additional shade at our park, including extra trees and/or a canopy.

Antique Street Lamps:

We are in the process of getting a bid from the City for the installation of 5 street lamps along Henderson.
