**DALLAS ISD
Five schools chosen for
Disney Musicals program**

The nonprofit AT&T Performing Arts Center announced that five Dallas ISD schools have been selected to participate in 2019 Disney Musicals in Schools. The program was developed by Disney Theatrical Productions to create sustainable theater programs in under-resourced elementary schools.

The five schools are L.O. Donald Leadership Academy, Ronald E. McNair Elementary School, School for the Talented and Gifted in Pleasant Grove, K.B. Polk Center for Academically Talented and Gifted, and Solar Preparatory School for Girls.

The schools will begin a 17-week musical theater residency in the spring. Teachers will partner with AT&T Performing Arts Center teaching artists to learn how to produce, direct, choreograph and music direct, culminating in a 30-minute Disney KIDS musical at each school.

Bulk Trash Pick Up is the week of the **third Monday of each month**. This month's pickup is **Dec 17**. Trash is usually picked up by Wednesday but can be earlier. You can set out your bulk trash as early as Thursday evening Dec 13.

Regular trash and recyclable materials (blue bin) are picked up once a week on Fridays. **A friendly reminder that trash cans are to be placed no earlier than 24 hours prior to pickup and removed from the curb within 24 hours after pickup.**

Bulk Trash Pick-Up Set Out Dates

- Thurs. Jan 17 – Sun. Jan 20
- Thurs. Feb 14 – Sun. Feb 17
- Thurs. Mar 14 – Sun. Mar 17

CHNA Meetings take place quarterly in March, June, September and December.
