### DALLAS ISD

Five schools chosen for Disney Musicals program

The nonprofit AT&T Performing Arts Center announced that five Dallas ISD schools have been selected to participate in 2019 Disney Musicals in Schools. The program was developed by Disney Theatrical Productions to create sustainable theater programs in underresourced elementary schools.

The five schools are L.O. Donald Leadership Academy, Ronald E. Mc-Nair Elementary School, School for the Talented and Gifted in Pleasant Grove, K.B. Polk Center for Academically Talented and Gifted, and Solar Preparatory School for Girls.

The schools will begin a 17-week musical theater residency in the spring. Teachers will partner with AT&T Performing Arts Center teaching artists to learn how to produce, direct, choreograph and music direct, culminating in a 30-minute Disney KIDS musical at each school.
